Important Information About Procedures for Opening a New Account (the Lease or Loan)

The provision of a Social Insurance Number ("SIN") is optional, however, if you do not provide your SIN, the time required to process the application may increase and PNC may not receive accurate information about your credit rating. PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction: PNC Vendor Finance Corporation Canada ("PNC") is committed to maintaining and protecting the confidentiality and security of the personal information we collect. In this regard, we have developed this Privacy Policy which outlines the manner in which we collect information and describes how we use, disclose and safeguard the personal information that we collect. PNC shall process your personal information only accordance with this Privacy Policy and with applicable data protection laws.

Collection of Personal Information: PNC collects personal information and financial information in order to provide you with the financial services that you have requested. This information may include your name, address, SIN number and date of birth. We may gather this information from you by personal interview, telephone, facsimile, electronic mail, the Internet or from other sources with your consent, such as credit rating agencies, regulatory agencies and references.

Use: Your personal information will be used by PNC for performing credit verifications, verifying your identity, providing and improving our financial products and services, inclusion in our contract administration and customer relationship management systems, compliance with applicable laws, rules and regulations, detection and prevention of fraud, money laundering and other unlawful activities, maintaining and – subject to your prior authorization – expanding our commercial relationship with you (e.g. through direct marketing), and to conduct market research. PNC may also use your personal information to syndicate and securitize financial products to other financial companies.

Disclosure: PNC may share your personal information within its group and also with third parties, including partner companies and other companies involved in provision of PNC services, for the purposes set out above. PNC may also disclose your personal information to syndicate and securitize financial products to other financial companies. PNC will use its best efforts to ensure that these third parties will abide by the principles laid down in this Privacy Policy. To the extent these parties will process your personal information on our behalf; we will require that they take adequate measures to ensure the safety and integrity of your personal information. Some of these parties may be located outside of Canada, including in the United States. PNC may use and disclose your personal information to assignees, prospective assignees and other third parties in connection with the proposed or actual financing, insuring, sale, securitization, assignment or other disposal of all or part of PNC's business or assets for the purposes of evaluating and/or performing these transactions. PNC may disclose personal information where permitted or required by law, including foreign laws applicable to us, our group companies or service providers.

Storage and Safeguarding of Information:

The file containing your personal information will be maintained at PNC's offices, or in consolidated secure systems maintained by PNC or its affiliates and will be accessible by employees, agents and service providers of PNC who require access to perform their duties. PNC uses reasonable measures to safeguard personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, loss or misuse. All personal information that we collect is stored securely. Electronic files are kept in a highly secure environment with restricted access. Paper based files are kept in a restricted area in locked filing cabinets. Access to private information is restricted to authorized employees who have a legitimate business reason for accessing it.

Retention of Information: Personal information is retained in accordance with our record retention policies. Our record retention periods are established taking into account requirements of privacy laws, the purposes for which the information was collected, legal and regulatory requirements to retain the information for minimum periods, limitation periods for taking legal action, and our business needs.

Your Access to Personal Information: We will provide you with access to the personal information that we have collected, subject to legal restrictions. In the event that any information held in your personal files is inaccurate, incomplete, irrelevant, or in violation with laws and regulations, please provide us with current information so that we may make the proper changes.

Rights: You also have the right to object, free of charge, if you do not want to receive information on our financial products and services which we may send to you from time to time. To do so, please notify PNC at the address provided in our mailing to you.
